## *Daughters of the King*

### Day 1

*Galatians 4:4-7*

**Is it easy or difficult for you to view God as your father?**

**What aspects of your identity as God's child give you comfort?**

**What aspects of your identity as God's child are difficult to accept?**

*Read Deuteronomy 32:10-11*

**What does this picture show you about God's heart for you?**

*Read Deuteronomy 8:5, Jeremiah 30:11, and Hebrews 12:5-13*

**How has God disciplined you lately?**

**In what ways do you resist or rebel against God's discipline?**

**Take some time and journal about your relationship with God as your father. What rebellion resides in your heart? Do you trust Him completely right now to take care of you? What do you need to thank Him for right now?**

## Day 2

*Read Galatians 4:4-7 again*

**What Law (s) do you find yourself enslaved by?**

**In what way has this law been your taskmaster?**

**Is there anything you think you owe God? Is there anything you think someone owes you?**

**Do you truly believe that your debts have been cancelled? Are there any debts that someone owes you that you need to cancel?**

**Are you living as a slave right now, or are you living as someone whose status has changed? What is the difference?**

**In light of what you have learned about adoption in Roman culture, what does it mean that you have been adopted as God's child?**

*Read Ephesians 1:5*

**Write down some words or phrases that stand out to you in this passage.**

## Day 3

*Galatians 4:4-7*

**Pick one verse to meditate on today. Write it out.**

**Why did you pick this verse?**

**Is there any imagery in the verse?**

**What does the verse bring to mind about your life?**

**Are there any words you don't understand? Write them down and then look up their meanings either in a regular dictionary or on Biblegateway.com. What other verses have those words in them.**

**Does the verse bring up any questions in your heart?**

**Go to Biblegateway.com again. Look up the verse in different translations. Write out a few. What are the differences? Do you gain any new insight?**
